






The Meadoway Class EA

The Meadoway Class EA will identify and evaluate a range of alternative trail alignments (and associated pedestrian bridge and road crossings) focusing on the three "incomplete" sections of the 16 kilometre hydro corridor where no multi-use trails currently exist. Phase 1 and 2 of The Meadoway Class EA are underway and include the following components: guiding principles, opportunity statement, EA objectives, existing conditions, preliminary alternative trail alignments and proposed criteria to evaluate the preliminary alternative trail alignments.

Preliminary Visualization Toolkit

In compliment to The Meadoway Class EA, a "visualization toolkit" is being created to help animate the look and feel of The Meadoway and demonstrate what is possible for the future of the hydro corridor. Phase 1 of the visualization toolkit is underway and includes the following components: review of existing conditions, opportunities and challenges, concept plan, preliminary cross sections, and sketch renderings (artistic depictions).
