



The span of green open space before the highway creates an enclave condition and entrance. Due to the rolling topography, garden planting could enhance the changes in grade, with a lookout point to highlight this. For safety purposes, restricted areas around the highway and accompanying infrastructure (e.g. maintenance storage facilities, landfill, etc.) should be visually and physically buffered with planting.
