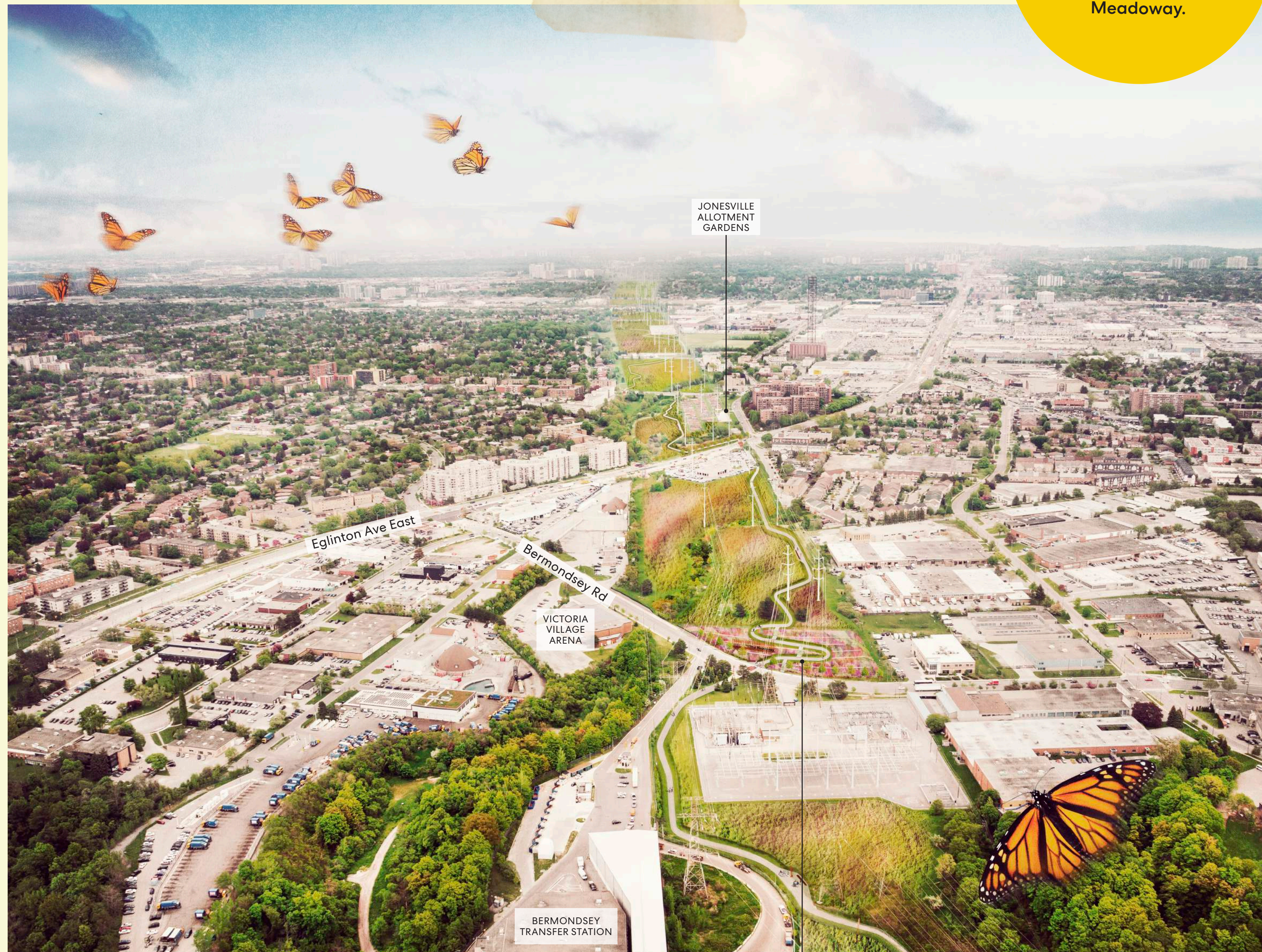

Meadows are habitat for important ecological communities. The Meadowway will serve as year-round habitat for some species, while providing a migrating corridor for others passing through, as they fuel up for their journey to warmer over-wintering regions.

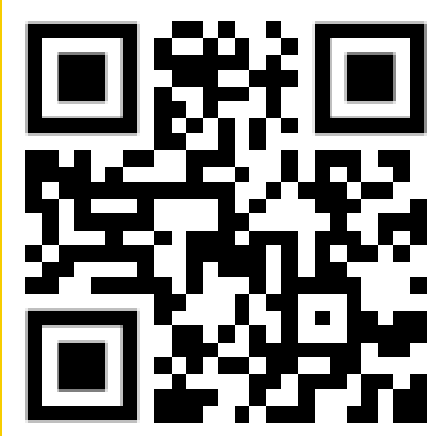
